

Poultry and meat products

Not just pork!
All poultry and meat products are regulated!



Even-toed ungulates
pig, cattle, sheep, deer



Odd-toed ungulates
horse, donkey



Poultry
chicken, duck, goose, turkey

Products with processed meat

These contain meat!
Maximum **NT\$one million** fine for bringing to Taiwan!



Jerky, sausage, ham, bacon, fried pork rind



Meat dumpling, tangyuan containing meat



Pastries containing meat, sandwiches, pork floss egg roll, mooncake



Frozen pet jerky, rawhide

Other animal products

Not just meat!
Be careful of other animal products!



Fresh milk, raw egg, semi-cooked egg



Organ, black pudding, blood sausage



Bones, horn, fur, and feathers that have not been properly processed

Fresh plant products

Fines for bringing processed or sprout-capable fresh items to Taiwan!



Vegetables
salad, lemongrass



Flowers and fruits
fresh flowers, fruits



Rhizomes
ginseng, sweet potato, lotus root



Plants
succulent plants, Tillandsia

Plant products with the ability to germinate

Dry-looking plant products can still sprout and root.



Spices
scallion, ginger, garlic, spices with seeds



Legume seeds
peanut, black bean, mung beans



Other seeds
quinoa, chia, flaxseed
